THE ROLE

The role of the Children's Director is to oversee the life and direction of Skyline Children's ministry on all campuses under the direction and leadership of the Senior Pastor (SP) Jeremy McGarity. This requires a firm grasp of the beliefs, values and strategy of Skyline Church and the ability to align staff and key leadership teams with its mission, vision, purpose, core values and core behaviors (Core Identity). The Children's Director will offer pastoral leadership to the campus and ensure the systems, practices and policies of the church responsibly and effectively support its ministry activities.

RESPONSIBLE FOR:

1. Modeling Biblical Priorities

Responsible for upholding Biblical priorities and core values of SKYLINE Church. The Children's Director should represent a growing personal relationship with Christ. The Children's Director models a strong relationship with his or her spouse (if married) and children (if applicable). The Children's Director strives to fulfill his or her purpose in life and ministry while demonstrating integrity in words, relationships, and actions. These objectives are accomplished by:

- Committing to a daily quiet-time with God.
- Setting appropriate boundaries to protect character and integrity.
- Developing personal evangelism opportunities with your oikos outside the church.
- Supporting the ministries of Skyline Church by faithfully giving at least 10% of gross income.
- Adhering to and encompassing the qualities and characteristics required of Skyline Church employees, as defined by the Staff Handbook and Core Identity Book.

2. Product

- Embed the Skyline core identity in the culture of our children's ministry through intentional strategies.
- Supervise, organize and lead Sunday services.
- Oversee Lakeside campus.
- Oversee special needs ministry.
- Supervise and organize the Awana ministry.
- Supervise, organize and lead all-church family events.
- Supervise, organize and lead children's specific events (Ex Adventure Day Camp).



- Manage the annual approved budget for the Children's ministry.

3. People

- Spiritual oversight / mentorship of students and leaders in our children's ministry.
- Hiring, setting expectations, training, coaching and celebrating volunteers and paid staff in our children's ministry.

4. Participation

- Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday prayer
- Weekly staff meetings
- Monthly all-staff meetings
- Staff retreats
- Attend a weekly Sunday service for personal growth
