

Youth Camp 2021 Packing list / Pre-camp information

Before Packing Please remember that your student will have to carry all of their luggage. We enjoy a simple lifestyle at camp, so please pack light. All luggage should have your name and Campus by the Sea written on a tag or label.

Label Everything: Please be sure to label all of your students belongings please include Skyline so camp staff know what group it belongs to.

Expensive Items: In the hustle and bustle of camp, items have a habit of getting broken or lost. Be conscious about sending your student with expensive items.

What to Bring:

- Shoes for Hiking (we will be going on a hike one of the days)
 - **Water Shoes/Sandals with ankle strap.** (The beach is a rocky beach. Barefoot water activates can be painful.)
 - **Flashlight** (There is no electricity in cabins)
 - Toiletries
 - Swim & Shower Towels
- Sleeping Bag & Pillow (or other bedding arrangements)
- Bible & Pen
- Sunscreen & Sunglasses
- Modest Swimsuit (Ladies must have their stomach covered, No Speedos)
 - Also, If the only suit you have is a two-piece, then you will have to wear a shirt over it.
 - Refillable Water Bottle
 - Clothes that can get messy
 - Athletic clothes (Basketball Court, and other activities are provided at this camp)

Bring Money for:

• **Camp Store:** Open each afternoon and the half hour prior to your departure from camp. Items available: sundries, souvenirs, beverages and snacks. Cash, and debit cards (\$5 minimum) accepted.

Note about cell phones: There is no cell phone service or wifi at camp and no secure place to charge phones or devices so it is suggested that your student leave their phone at home.

What NOT to Bring:

- Alcohol, Tobacco Products or Illegal Drugs
- Radios, Candles, TVs, computers, tablets, electrical gadgets, drones, weapons pocket knives, pets, spearfishing gear or SCUBA diving equipment.

Medication

• *Every camp participant must fill out an individual release form. **Minor's form must have parent/guardian signature and emergency contact phone number.*** A Camper Medication Information sheet must be completed by a parent or guardian for any camper bringing prescription or over-the-counter medication. Prescription drugs for minor campers & chaperones must be in originally labeled bottles/packaging (no loose meds in baggies, zip

locks, or pill organizers) and given to the camp's Health Supervisor for dispensing. Medication refrigeration is available. There is a medical clinic in Avalon and 911 service for emergencies.

Dress Code:

- Shorts/skirts must reach fingertips when arms are down at sides
- Please dress modestly as this is a faith based camp and we are guests at a faith based facility.
- Cover-ups must be worn to and from the beach and in the dining hall. No swimsuits or wet clothes are allowed in the dining hall.

Drop off & Pick up at Skyline Youth Center (Rancho Location)

(Please eat lunch before drop off for camp, as we will not be able to stop for food!)

Middle School Camp:

Drop off: Saturday, June 26 • 11-11:30am

Pick up: Tuesday, June 29 • 4-4:30pm

(Traffic could delay pick up)

High School Camp:

Drop off: Wednesday, June 30 • 11-11:30am

Pick up: Saturday, July 3 • 4-4:30pm

(Traffic could delay pick up)

Messages and Mail:

The camp phone number is (310) 510-0015. (answered 9am-5pm daily)

The camp address is Campus by the Sea, #1 Gallaghers Cove, P.O. Box 466, Avalon, CA 90704. Mail goes out daily at approximately 3:00pm. A mailbox for outgoing mail is located outside the camp office. Mail to campers should be sent a full two days before the event, packages a full 3 to 4 days before the event (not recommended for weekend camps).

Special Travel and Parental Visits: Visitors to camp, late arrival, or early departure of campers are all highly discouraged since they disrupt the community, objectives of program and flow of camp experience. Any exceptions granted are at the prerogative of camp director. Missed days or missed legs of ferry charter are not refunded. Any travel arrangement and cost outside of the camp-chartered boat is camper's responsibility. Arrangements need to be communicated in advance to camp registrar. Additional charges will apply if shore-boats or camp boats are needed to transport a group or individual into or out of Avalon. Typically, a \$20 shuttle fee each way.

Disciplinary Action: Any camper sent home for disciplinary reasons will pay all their own travel and related expenses, forfeit all camp fees.
