THE ROLE

The High School Pastor provides leadership and spiritual shepherding for Skyline Church's ministry to High School students (grades 9 through 12) and their families partnering with parents to build disciples of the next generation. They will commit to creating an exciting, fun, challenging and growing ministry that engages all high school students. They should develop vision and infrastructure for this area that is in alignment with Skyline Church's ministry strategies and philosophy. They should be a team player and follow the biblical model of sacrifice by putting the needs of others in front of their own.

POSITION QUALIFICATIONS:

- Spiritual maturity and personal integrity.
- Visionary with initiative and entrepreneurial spirit.
- Commitment to the Mission of Skyline church : We exist to help people Find and Follow Jesus 7 Days a Week.
- On-stage leadership and Dynamic Communication skills.
- Functional ability in use of current technology.
- Administrative capacity, and ability to train an administrative assistant.
- Leads with humility, commitment, and strong work ethic.
- Willingness to submit to spiritual authority.

RESPONSIBLE FOR:

1. Modeling Biblical Principles

Responsible for upholding Biblical principles and core values of Skyline Church. The High School Pastor should represent a growing personal relationship with Christ. The High School Pastor models a strong relationship with his or her spouse (if married) and children (if applicable). The High School Pastor strives to fulfill his or her purpose while demonstrating integrity in words, relationships and actions. These objectives are accomplished by:

- Committing to a daily quiet-time with God.
- Setting appropriate boundaries to protect character and integrity.
- Developing personal evangelism opportunities with your oikos outside the church.
- Supporting the ministries of Skyline Church by faithfully giving at least 10% of gross income.
- Adhering to and encompassing the qualities and characteristics required of Skyline Church employees, as defined by the Staff Handbook and Core Identity Book.

2. The Position

- Cast vision for a healthy ministry consistent with Skyline Church's mission, vision and values helping students "Find and Follow Jesus Seven Day a Week."
- Develop and lead environments, activities and programming that will enable and encourage spiritual growth in the High School students with a focus on Tuesday Nights.
- Lead volunteers and student leaders to accomplish the vision of our ministry (every Tuesday from 7-9 PM, and once a month on Saturdays, amongst other times).
- Develop and come up with disciple materials.... Lead SkyHigh Next.
- Maintain, and continue to develop, our strategy for communicating with students and families.
- Lead and develop relationships with local school leadership and be seen on campuses and at community events.
- Recruit, equip, develop and encourage volunteers and leaders for Sky High.
- Operate within a ministry budget and steward the funds well.
- Participate in the development and execution of church wide events.
- Continue to implement our strategy to assimilate students and families into the life of the church (Specifically to serve on Sunday morning).
- Speak for Today Matters.
- Plan camps & outreaches.
- Meet with students and families to talk with and give counsel on life, faith, etc.
- Attend staff meeting every week and be a part of the global discussions for our church.
- Lead with a servant's heart, demonstrate genuine care and concern, while acting with humility and integrity, when encouraging the efforts of all team members (1 Peter 5:1-4).
- Help Skyline achieve its mission to prepare every generation to change their world for Christ, through the people, work product, and results of the High School Ministry.
- Participate in weekly prayer and staff meetings.
