Position: Broadcast Video Director (Full-Time)

THE ROLE

The Broadcast Video Director leads Skyline's video ministry, ensuring excellent live and online worship experiences while developing healthy volunteer teams and maintaining reliable video systems. The Broadcast Video Director is part of the Worship & Creative Art Department and reports to the Production Director.

RESPONSIBLE FOR:

1. Modeling Biblical Priorities

The Broadcast Video Director is responsible for upholding Biblical priorities and core values of Skyline Church. The Broadcast Video Director should represent a growing personal relationship with Christ. The Broadcast Video Director models a strong relationship with his or her spouse (if married) and children (if applicable). The Broadcast Video Director strives to fulfill his or her purpose while demonstrating integrity in words, relationships and actions. These objectives are accomplished by:

- Committing to a daily quiet-time with God.
- Setting appropriate boundaries to protect character and integrity.
- Developing personal evangelism opportunities with your oikos outside the church.
- Supporting the ministries of Skyline Church by faithfully giving at least 10% of gross income.
- Adhering to and encompassing the qualities and characteristics required of Skyline Church employees, as defined by the Staff Handbook and Core Identity Book.
- Lead with a servant's heart, demonstrate genuine care and concern, while acting with humility and integrity, when encouraging the efforts of all team members (1 Peter 5:1-4).

2. Key Responsibilities

- Oversee all broadcast video production for weekend services, special events, and the Online Campus.
- Lead and shepherd the Video Dream Team volunteers.
- Recruit, train, schedule, and develop video volunteers.
- Maintain and improve video systems across campuses.
- Ensure livestream, recording, playback, and IMAG systems are functioning properly.

- Oversee service archives and media management.
- Develop and maintain video standards and SOPs.
- Work with Worship, Creative, and Production teams to enhance the worship experience.
- Assist with future video upgrades and system planning.
- Support the Online Campus, which is produced as a separately curated service with its own Production Manager.
- Stay proficient in video technologies and workflows.

- Strong relationship with Jesus and alignment with Skyline's mission and values.
- Experience with professional live video systems.
- Familiarity with Blackmagic switchers, Ross routing/switching systems, ProPresenter, ProVideoPlayer, streaming encoders, camera shading and engineering workflows.
- Ability to lead volunteers and create a healthy team culture.
- Strong troubleshooting and organizational skills.
